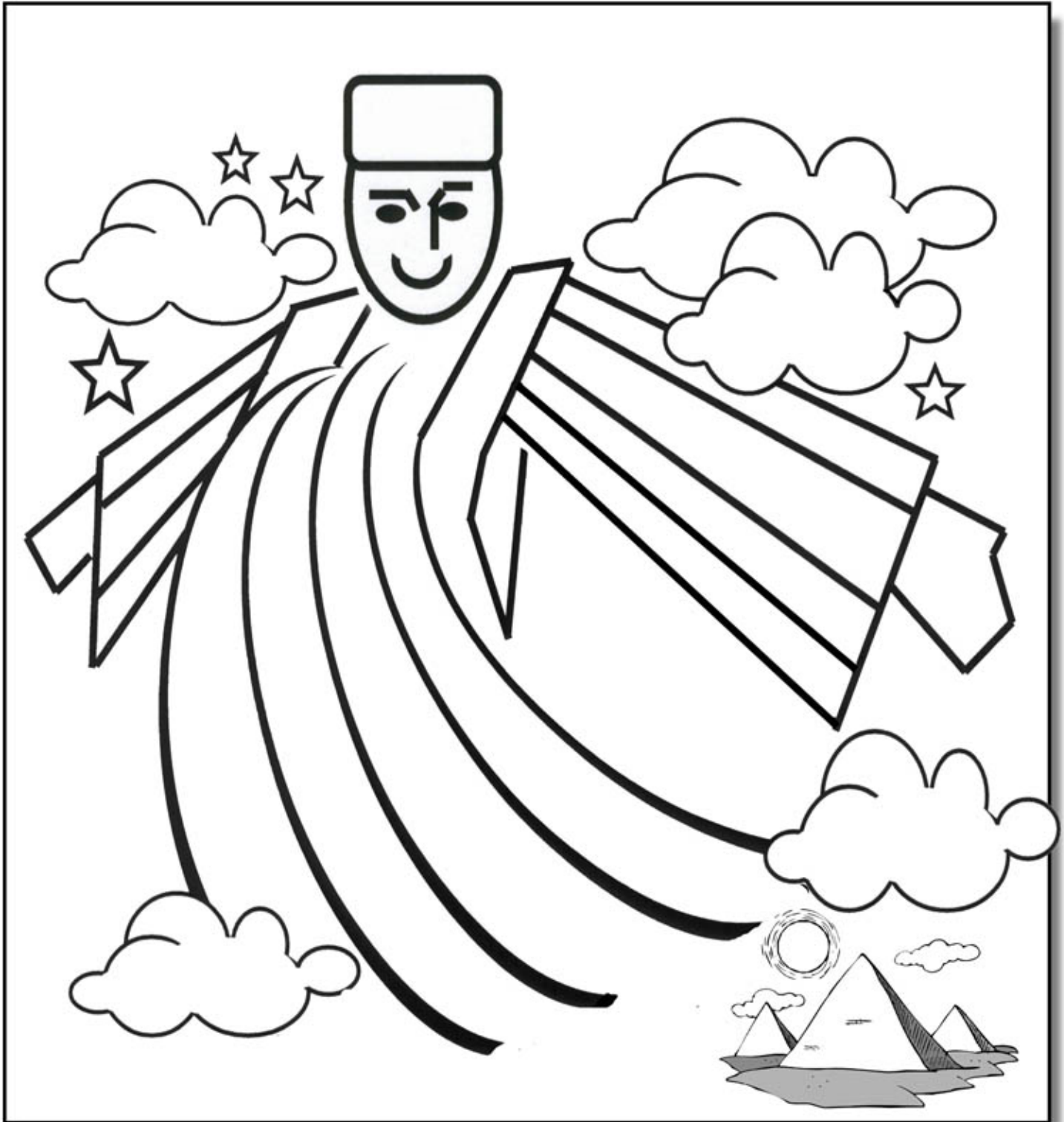


Joseph Was A Dreamer!
